Coverage errors are one of the most important types of error, since they affect not only the accuracy of the counts of the various census universes, but also the accuracy of all of the census data describing the characteristics of these universes.</p> <p>For the first time, there will be a technical report on imputation to provide valuable information on the census edit and imputation (E&I) process.
